Theft of \$100K in merchandise puts four on most-wanted list

Four men who allegedly stole expensive items from two upscale Back Bay retail stores in the past three weeks, including a grab-and-run of more than \$100,000 in merchandise Friday, are on the state's Most Wanted list.

An [online case description](#) says that four men rushed into the Chanel store on Newbury Street Friday and left with around 45 of the designer's bags and additional female accessory items exceeding \$100,000 in value.

The suspects then ran and escaped into the Boston Public Garden, authorities say.

The are believed to be the same people who robbed the Louis Vuitton store in the Copley Place Mall in a similar fashion on Sept. 16 and 26, according to the case description. The value of the merchandise stolen in the prior two thefts was not immediately available.

The alleged thieves were captured on store security cameras, and their photos are posted the Mass. Most Wanted website's [case page](#).

Boston police said Monday afternoon that none of the photographed suspects have been identified.
