

## Boston Landmarks Orchestra relocates offices to Brighton

**The Boston Landmarks Orchestra has moved to a new office headquarters in Brighton.**

The orchestra’s three full-time and three part-time office workers completed their relocation last week to a second-floor Guest Street building suite attached to WGBH’s studios where media partner FM radio station 99.5 All Classical is housed.

Formed in 2001, the orchestra has held concerts – all free of charge – in and around Boston drawing in nearly a half million people combined to performances during the past decade.

The DCR’S Hatch Memorial Shell on the Esplanade remains the orchestra’s performing home. The orchestra’s performances have been based there 2007, but the orchestra also performs elsewhere in Greater Boston, including in a first-ever symphonic show at Fenway Park last year.

Since its inception, the orchestra’s office headquarters in Cambridge had been based in the Brattle Street residence of its late founder Conductor Charles Ansbacher.

The new office space will allow for further collaboration with 99.5 All Classical, including use of studio space for orchestra rehearsals, said a spokeswoman for the orchestra. The office move was first reported on by WickedLocal.com.

The orchestra’s new office address is 10 Guest Street, Suite 280. The office phone number is 617-987-2000; its fax number is 617 987 0195. All e-mail addresses will remain the same.

Its 2011 season will open July 13 and will run every Wednesday at 7 p.m. through August 31. A special concert will be held PineBank in Jamaica Plain on July 31.




