A program is offering free kayaking along the Charles River in West Roxbury on select dates this summer.

Run by the Boston Parks and Recreation Department and Maine-based retail company L.L. Bean, the program at Millennium Park provides two instructors and 14 kayaks for three sessions on the following Saturdays: June 23, July 14 and July 21, according to city parks officials.

The first of the program's four sessions was held June 16. That date had **sold out**, as has the June 23rd session, city officials said. Sign-up for the two July dates is expected to begin soon at www.cityofboston.gov/parks.

The program is open to anyone 8 and older, officials said.
