Free photography workshops to be held at parks around Boston this summer

Free photography workshops will be held at various parks around Boston during July and August, city officials said.

The third annual "Pics in the Parks" initiative will be hosted by ParkARTS, a program of the Boston Parks and Recreation Department.

Workshops will be held each Monday at 6 p.m. from July 16 through Aug. 13 before the program concludes with a special session at 11 a.m. on Sat., Aug. 18, at Spectacle Island, according to the city.

The workshops are open to anyone with a camera and will be led by photography instructor Sarah Berry, who is pursuing a masters of arts administration at Boston University, the city said. She has experience introducing photography to children, teens and adults, and has worked as a photographer in different settings including an internship with the Smithsonian Institution. Her work is part of collections around Boston and has been shown
