hotels throughout Boston have donated thousands of pies to Community Servings' Pie in the Sky initiative, helping to raise a total of \$6 million used to help feed those who are critically ill, too sick to shop or cook for themselves.

The donated pies are sold at \$25 a piece to family, friends and colleagues by more than 600 volunteers. The money from each sold pie provides a week's worth of home-delivered meals to a client in Community Servings programming.

The nonprofit feeds people in eastern Massachusetts who suffer from any critical illness, along with their dependents and caregivers.

Last November, Pie in the Sky sold more than 15,000 pies, raised \$550,000 including direct donations and put 60 cents out of every dollar toward the ...
