said.

The falling concrete did not cause injuries or affect commuter rail service, spokesman Joe Pesaturo said.

He said an engineering and maintenance crew has closed off a small platform so workers can inspect the ceiling.

The spokesman said that “it appears that some small pieces of concrete have fallen from the ceiling,” but officials have not yet determined what caused the concrete to fall.

“If any pieces of concrete appear to be loose, they will be removed,” Pesaturo said.
