#### Here are some interesting facts about Airbnb in Boston:

- The Back Bay is home to the most Airbnb listings of any neighborhood. There were 188 properties advertised there, according to a Globe review of data collected earlier this month by online data extraction software company <u>import.io</u>.
- The average price per night for an Airbnb stay in the Back Bay is \$239.58, around the same as the average for hotel rooms in the neighborhood, which, as of 2013, was \$230 per night, according to a <u>report</u> by the Boston Redevelopment Authority.
- The area of Boston with the second largest number of listings is Allston-Brighton, where rates were far lower, averaging \$119.35 per night, the Globe's analysis found.

- For the year ending in June 2014, some 34,000 people visited Boston using Airbnb, contributing an estimated \$51 million to the area's economy, including spending \$8.8 million on Airbnb bookings, according to the company.
- More than half of hosts said the extra income the typical host in Boston earns \$8,000 per year has helped them to stay in their homes, according to the company.

## Types of properties listed on Airbnb

Of the 1,496 listings in Boston, the typical ad is for a one-bed, one-bathroom spot with a 4.6 out of 5 rating.

• The user with the most listings was not an individual. It was a relocation agency named SeamlessTransitions, which had 56 properties listed. The company provides an array of services to help companies move people to a new city. The owner, Kitty Franklin, said the 10-year-old business existed before Airbnb and the site is just one of the ways it advertises.



The Globe's analysis found there are about 350 listings on HomeAway and 175 more on FlipKey. Other sites where people advertise their homes include 9Flats, Roomorama, VRBO, and Craigslist.
