In addition to regular pay, many MBTA employees will collect significant overtime pay. Many are also owed back pay, or retroactive pay raises. All told, 24 percent of T workers will earn more than \$100,000 in 2015. (Note: The gross pay figures in this chart do not account for the entire annual rate amounts because the calendar year is not finished.)
