

The demographics of gun owners, and why they own them

Researchers from Harvard and Northeastern universities released some of findings from a new study

on gun ownership in America this week.

One of the more striking results of the study was that <u>half of the guns in the United States are owned</u> just 3 percent of adults in the country.

The study has not yet been published, but a summary of its findings was released exclusively this week to a pair of news outlets, the Guardian and the Trace.

The study was based on a survey of nearly 4,000 adults, researchers said. The full results of the study are undergoing peer review and are due to be released next fall by the Russell Sage Foundation.








Below are data on some additional findings researchers provided to the two news outlets.

The figures show some clear trends, including that gun owners in 2015 were most likely to be white men, over 45 years old, with at least some college education, conservative views, and living in rural areas. Military veterans were more likely to own a gun than nonveterans. Similarly, people who grew up with a gun in their household were more likely to own than those who did not. The most common reason for owning a gun was for protection against other people:


Percentage who own a firearm, 2015
