Each "place of last drink" — or "PLD" — report represents an instance in which the establishment allegedly served the last drink to an intoxicated person who was then arrested and later convicted for operating under the influence. Figures are based on data from Jan. 2012 through Sept. 2016.

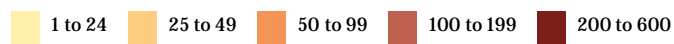

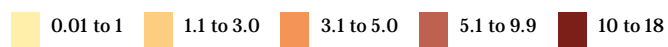
Municipalities with the most "place of last drink" reports

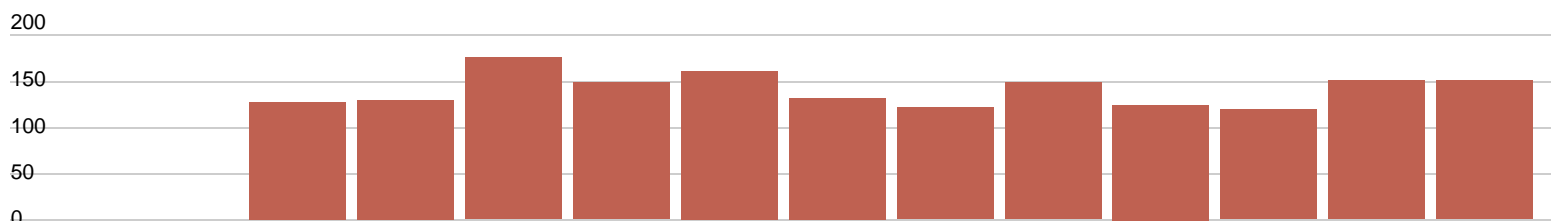
"Place of last drink" reports per capita

Average number of OUI arrests resulting in a conviction in each month

Due in large part to St. Patrick's Day, March is the month with the most drunk driving arrests resulting in convictions on average. Upticks in arrests also occur around Memorial Day in May and during the winter holiday season that stretches from Thanksgiving to New Year's Day. Figures are based on available data for the calendar years 2012 through 2015.

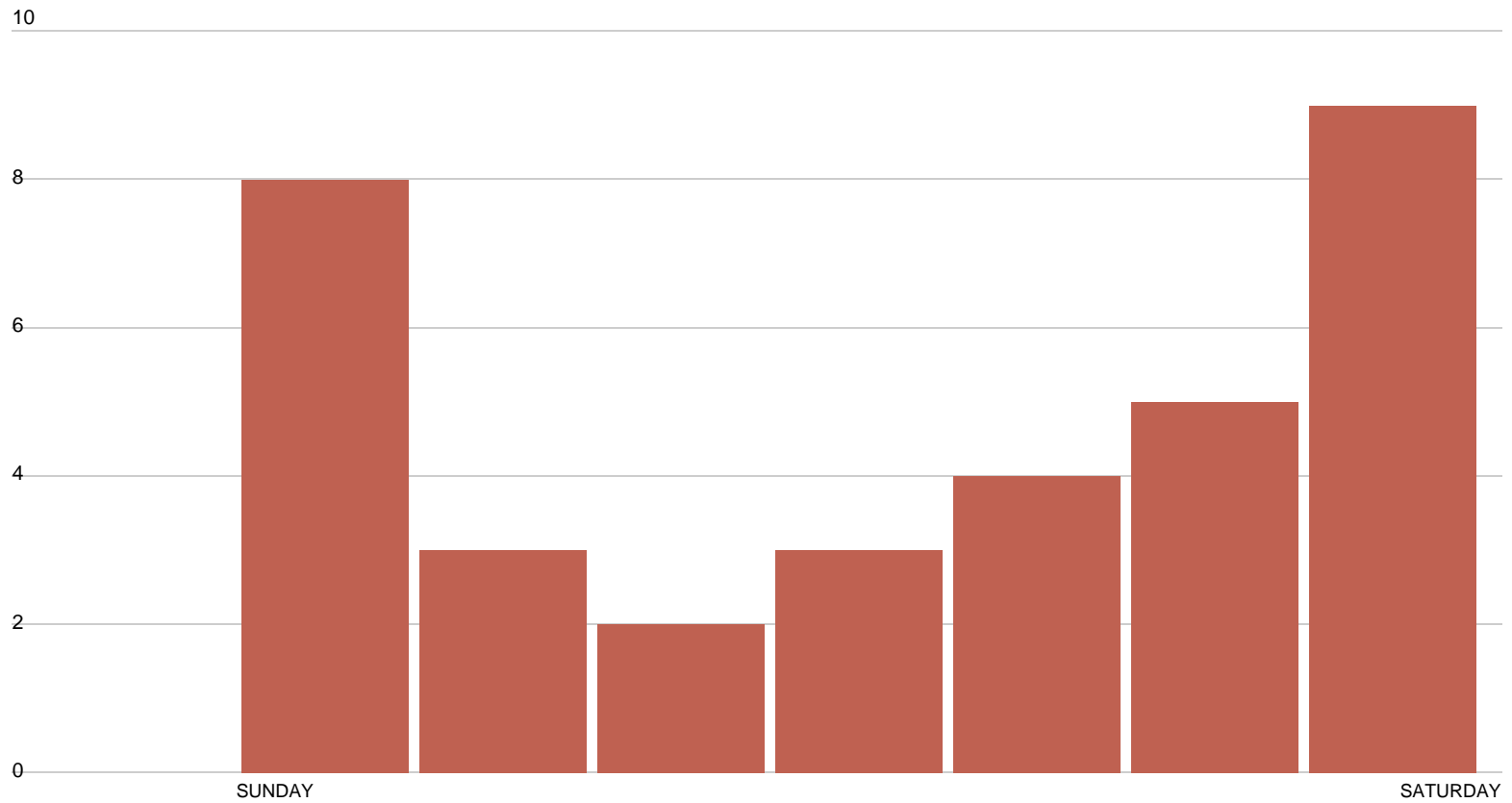

Average number of OUI arrests resulting in a conviction in each day of the week

Unsurprisingly, most arrests for operating under the influence occur on the weekend. On any given Saturday in Massachusetts, an average of nine people are arrested for driving drunk and later convicted, the most of any day of the week. Figures are based on available data for the calendar years 2012 through 2015.
