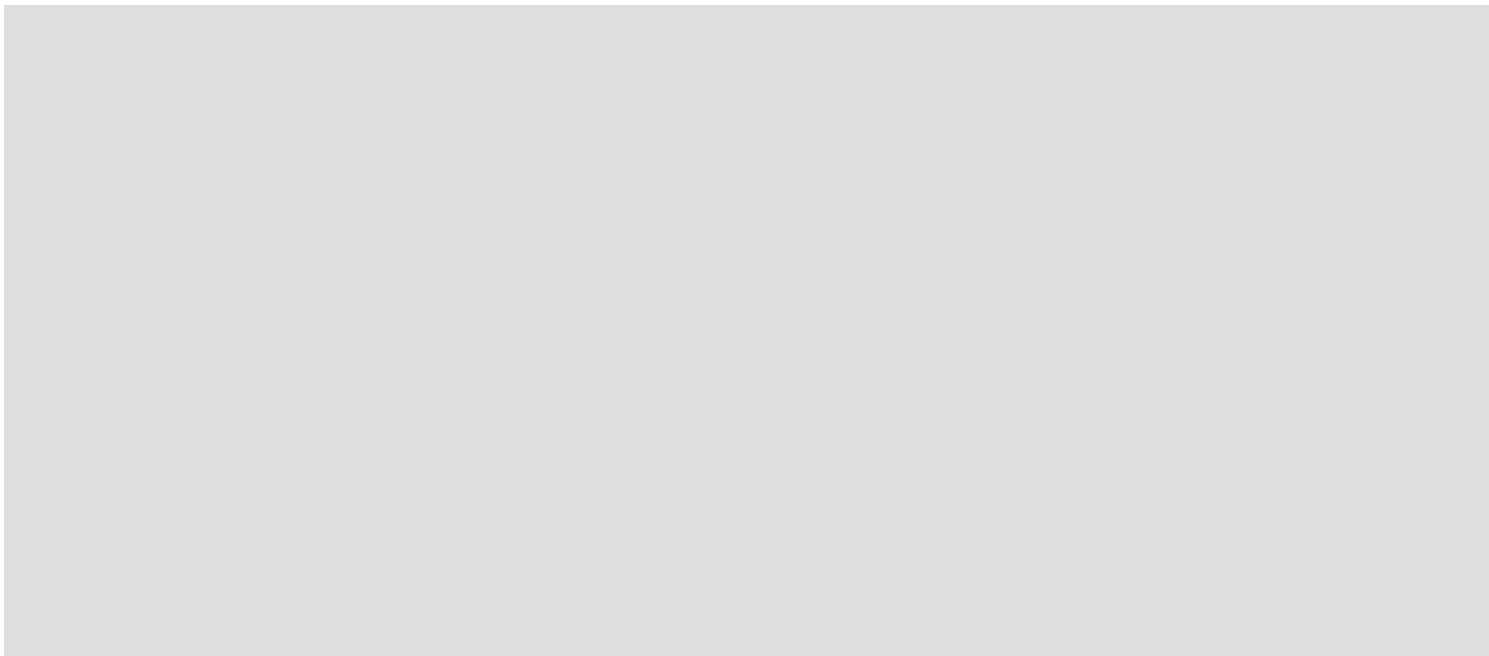

Where non-immigrant visitors to the US come from

This map shows, for each foreign country, the number of non-immigrant admissions to the United States during fiscal year 2015, the 12-month period that ended Sept. 30, 2015. Admissions represent counts of arrivals, not unique individuals. One individual can account for multiple admissions in a given year. Data are based on admissions to the US that involved the use of I-94 forms. Examples of I-94 form admissions include temporary visitors for business and pleasure, temporary workers, and students.
