Reported hate crimes at New England colleges

The table below is sorted to show first campuses with the highest rates of reported hate crimes per 1,000 students. The list below includes four-year public and private nonprofit colleges in New England with at least 1,500 students.

The federal Education Department defines a hate crime as "a criminal offense that manifests evidence that the victim was intentionally selected because of the perpetrator's bias against the victim." Hate crimes can include: intimidation; property destruction, damage, or vandalism; assault; larceny; aggravated assault; robbery; burglary; rape; vehicle theft; arson; forcible fondling; and murder. In recent years, the vast majority of cases on college campuses have been intimidation or property destruction, damage, or vandalism.

(Note: This table previously listed figures that double counted the number of some hate crime reports for some campuses.)
